Dr Alexandra K. Papadopoulou is currently appointed as full-time academic staff in the Division of Orthodontics, University of Geneva, Switzerland and also holds the position of an Honorary Senior Lecturer in the Department of Orthodontics and Paediatric Dentistry of the University of Sydney, where she previously served for seven years as a full-time academic staff. Dr Papadopoulou received her Dental Degree, Specialty Degree in Oral Surgery, Implantology and Dentomaxillofacial Radiology, Specialty Degree in Orthodontics and PhD from the Faculty of Dentistry, Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, Greece. She also completed a 2-year Fellowship in the Department of Histology and Embryology, Faculty of Medicine, Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, Greece. Dr Papadopoulou has supervised several DCLinDent (Orthodontics) Theses and Higher Research Degree projects. She has published numerous research papers in high impact, peer-reviewed journals and received several prizes from professional orthodontic societies for her contribution to the specialty's research. Her main research interests focus on the efficacy of dentofacial orthopaedic treatment, adjunct methods in accelerating orthodontics, skeletal anchorage devices, the biology of orthodontic tooth movement, obstructive sleep apnoea and airway changes induced by orthodontic treatment.
